- 1. The convention shall open each morning at 10 A.M.
- 2. A session shall be the meeting of the convention between roll calls. Roll Calls shall be made at 10 A.M., after lunch and after supper.
- 3. A delegate who has not taken his seat by the ending of the roll call shall not be seated for that session.
- 4. An alternate seated at the beginning of the session shall retain his seat for that session.
- 5. Alternate delegates shall have neither voice nor vote unless they have been seated as regular delegates.
- 6. Regular members of the National Committee and alternates to the N.C. are seated as fraternal delegates with voice and consultative vote.
- 7. On all resolutions and amendments with alloted discussion time of 60 minutes or over, discussion per speaker shall be limited to 10 minutes; where the alloted discussion time is less than 60 minutes, discussion shall be limited to 5 minutes per speaker.
- 8. No delegate may speak a second time on one report until all delegates who want the floor have spoken.
- 9. 51% of the delegates shall constitute a quorum.
- 10. A roll call vote can be granted by vote of 25% of the delegates.
- 11. The following shall be entitled to a fraternal delegate each: Southeast Mo., Reading, St.Louis, Boston, Hibbing and Youngstown.
- 12. Three members of the SYL are seated as fraternal delegates with voice and consubtative vote.
 - 13. The Chicago and New York minority of the SWP who have voted since the plenum of the SWP to join the Workers Party and have joined shall be entitled to regular delegates to our convention on the same basis of representation established in our convention call.
 - 14. Comrades from the ASP are seated as fraternal delegates.
 - 15. Voting except for the NC shall be by show of hands. Voting for the National Committee shall be ny ballot.
