STUDENT POLITICS

A GREAT hue and cry has been raised in the course of this ASUC election over the question of keeping strictly to campus issues. As if world events and their reflections in politics are to stop at the borders of the Robert's property, while inside, innocent students debate furiously over the issue of towels vs. hot air driers in the toilets.

THE RESULT of this approach is that both liberals and stalinist totalitarians run on the same program; the fraternity men have no program at all; and, only a handful of 'insiders' know who really stands for what. Is it any wonder the vast majority of students are apathetic and don't vote? What choice do they have when politics is reduced to the level of voting for nice guys?

THIS GENERAL SITUATION aids both the stalinists and the fraternity faction by giving each power they don't deserve -- The CP, by allowing them to pase as liberals; the frats, by enabling them to maintain their rule on a campus where they wouldn't last three seconds if exposed to the light.

WITH THESE circumstances in mind the Socialist Youth League is running a candidate for Rep-at-Large. Here there is no deception and all who vote for him can know exactly what as well as who they are voting for.

DEMOCRACY AND THE ASUC

ASUC ELECTIONS are fraudulent distortions of democracy. Frauds because 25% of the voting members of the ASUC ex-committee are non-student agents for either Sproul or the Alumni Association. Distorted because 25% of the student body, the Grad students, are deprived of full participation in the ASUC. Only those opposed to democratic principles can be proud of the abortive ASUC constitution in which the right of initiative was deleted at the express demand of president Sproul.

STUDENT APATHY in ASUC elections is sedulously cultivated by the hamstringing of vigorous electioneering on campus through the authority of the frat-controlled Judicial Committee, who's decisions are final and who crippled the on-campus campaign of ten candidates in this election. Cortainly there must be a body to supervise ASUC elections, but it should have power only to see that no candidate takes unfair advantage of others; and, obviously, such a committee should be elected by the students themselves.

THE USUAL lineup of office-seekers who wish to become student agents for the reactionary policies of 'I want to be governor' Sproul's administration, is graced by the presence of MAURICE O'CONNELL. This candidate for Rep-at-Large militantly declares himself in favor on academic freedom, against the banker-shyster contract oath, and for student demonstrations in support of the fight for academic freedom.

EVERY CANDIDATE represents some political philosophy. Fraternity row is an unquestioning supporter of Taft Republicanism; unaffiliated office-seekers are generally chamalions who's political hue depends on which way the wind blows. O'CONNELL is a member of the Socialist Youth League and represents politically a Third Camp against both Stalinism and Wall Street.

EXPOSE the prostitution of student government by voting for O'CONNELL for repat-large. VOTE FOR A REP WHO WILL NOT BE BOUGHT AND WHO CERTAINLY WILL NOT BE SILENT.
