THE CON-STITUTION OF THIS FASCIST COUNTRY GUARANTEES NO RIGHTS TO THE POLITICAL PRISONER, THE SAME WAY THAT IT DOES NOT GUARANTEE ANY OF US ANYTHING. THAT IS WHY THE PEOPLE MUST REWRITE THE CONSTITUTION TO RELATE TO THE NEEDS OF BLACK PEOPLE. THE MERE FACT THAT THE POLITICAL PRISONER REMAINS IN PRISON IS A DIRECT VIOLATION OF HIS CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS, THE BLACK PRISONER NEVER HAD A JUROR OF HIS OR HER PEER GROUP, WE ARE BRUTALIZED OUTSIDE OF PRISONS AS WELL AS IN, SO FOR THE BLACK PRISONER WHO KNOWS THAT-HE HAS NOTHING TO LOSE.

Four of the overgrown pigs. knocked at the front door of the apartment at 504 St. Andrew Street in the St. Thomas housing project about 4:20 pm on Tuesday, July 14th, Mrs. Morgan was not there and the door was answered by little Debra Brown, age II, one of the four children home at that time. As the little girl opened the door to see who was there, the four big pigs barged right on into the small apartment, one of them stepping on the foot of the child (causing it to swell), Seconds later two other oversized uniformed cowards entered through the rear

Wednesday, July 8, 1970, marked another day in the history books of Black Liberation, as Black people of New Hedford began the first act of resistance against the pigs of New Bedford.

The brothers dealt with the pign in small groups which proved succesaful in keeping the pigs confused. One pig was hit in the head from the rear with a sledge arrested they retaliated with hammer, which took six stitches to close. Many pigs were bricked and fire-bombed.

The shootings were by no means only confined to the pigs. The brothers carried out some rightcous acts of self-defense -- sulping at pigs in cars and fire-engines. One pig. Frank Perry, missed certian barbeculng when two slugs put a building six inches above his head.

The climax of the rebellion took place Samirday when 17 year old Lester Lims was murdered by four White racists; George Rose, 70; Garry Les Lauriers, 18; Halph D. Bruws, 20, another has not been found.

As the racists car approached about 50 people on Kempton Street, one of the racists reliched under his west, jumped out of his car and leveled a 17-gauge shotgun scross the bood of his car and pointed it at the more than 50 men, women, and children who had congregated on the sidewalk and began to fire, point blank. ing the shots, was hit in the stomach and neck. The racist then turned his gun, firing into the crowd hitting Kim Holland, 15, in the chest, as she ran to get out of the line of fire,

225 city and state pigs invaded and sealed off the 20 square block West Jille district of Ashbury Park New Jaracy, victorsty attacking the 8,500 Black residents with mane, tear gas pepper gas from portable machines, leaded billycluby and causing 251 Black people to be hospitalized with 125 of them treated for puncture wounds of the sort made by storgun pellets', according to the reports released from the hospital But betight about the mad dogs occupation and inhumane aggressive. acts. The Black people of Ashbury. New Jersy, armed themselves for self defense from racist opocasion wheth was commanded by, of all things, a boot eleag negro-Chief of pigs , Thomas Sydney Smith and got down holding their own to drive out the fascist pigs. Only after the Black people of the community got "community con-trol of police", (their own 28 man neighborhood parrol) did the brothers and sister agree to a temporay "uneasy peace" within the West side area.

Five days of the early summer revolt first erupted in New Bedford, Massachusetts, last Wednesday night after the illegal, cruel and unjust arrest of a lilack brother on the West End with 10 of the foul and deprayed play getting their fat butts beat on the spot and as a result the city sand states full riot over-kill contigency being called "with all deliberate speed" into the Black community. Only six brothers suffered minor injuries at the

time. But on Saturday night, fascist CIA agents sped through the Black community of New Bedford, firing shotgun blasts that murdered 12 year old Lester Lims and wounding three other Black youths that were with him at that time. Then all hell broke loose. The second amendment to the Constitution of the United States gives a right to bear arms. The niggers picked upguns and everything clse that was available to deal with the situation in a revolutionary manner and put the piggish power structure of the area up against the wall. The swines responded by immediately arresting three scapegoats, A White boy in a nearby area, and charged them with murder and attempted murder in an effort to cool off the area while hiding the fact that "Mealy Mouth Nixon's " CIA was

Highland Park, Michigan, declared a mate of emergency in their two days of direct confrontation with the Black community because of the shooting a Black bar patron cause they were angered and up- a by a White racist burtender. The bar was totally demolished and 21 other buildings in the area were firebonibed and had their windows amashed in the two days of revolt The shooting occured last Saturday when Grady Cash, a 61 year old White southern born KKK-er, tried to short change the Black brother and got caught in the act. Anargu-

ment ensued when the brother hipped him to the fact that he was square, frightening the avaricious plg and getting shot,

The complete take-over of a White owned Black operated radio station in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, by 300 Black people broadcast their strong protest against the greedy, money hungry advertisers on station KBYE using religious and ethnic music as a treacherous lure for the Black community, and let the nation know that "WE WANT AN END TO THE ROBBERY BY THE CAPITALIST OF OUR BLACK COMMUNITY" was a confrontation on a lesser level although it shook up almost all of the state of Oklahoma, the White racist in particular, who believed that the station take over was the prelude to a revolution.

"An anonymous cop in an anonymous city shoots to death an anonymous Black youth suspected of stealing a car, and riots, on the heels of the news, sweep the nation, Widespread looting is reported in a dozen cities. Roving bands of Black youths set buildings on fire, Shipers, firing on policemen and firemen, are reported in several cities, in two or three places, the National Guard is called out to restore order. 'Reponsible Negro Leaders', given prime time on radio and TV, appeal for calm; 'Cool it, Haby', they enjoin, but Baby isn't listening to them. Strangely, demonic mantacal Black demagogues raise their voices above the crescendo of chaon and madness, urging the marauders to burn America to the ground,"

Ashbury Park, N.J., July 10th --Six days after the beginning of the burning, showed shaky state and local pigs patrolling the Black colony (the West Side) in cars, What also was shown was the horrors of war, held up on crutches and painfully limping on strategical, and tactical mistakes, And the national news media has reported and is reporting it as if Hiroshima was a hot dog roast, or World War II was just practice. The cover of the Wednesday, July 8th edition of the "Evening the front. And the struggles of our people in Ashbury Park, N.J. didn't prove different, because it went down, and still, there was the inwanted slimy presence of the punk bootlickers.

At one point, the youth just expelled Hamm and his Jacknape associates from the community center, and they sat down to do some thinking on the grassroot subject of the day--survival. After about 1 1/2 hours five Black men entered the room who were soon to prove themselves as another, lower grade of bootsuckers. 2,100 retired high ranking officers are holding executive positions in the top 100 war contracting firms. These 100 firms receive 68% of the Pentagon's business. The ten leading 'defense' firms employ 1,005 retired officers. These ten firms ripped off 25% of the war trade,

A REVOLUTIONARY ACT IN CHICAGO: TWO PIGS DEAD STRUGGLE AHEAD

in the Black colony of Chicago the people intensified the struggle by offing two more of Chicago's fascist pigs, and the Chicago pig force as usual gave another lesson on how to detain and arrest an entire community. The two pigs who were shot as they illegally occupied our community, were part of a walk and talk team, their job was to get information on the revolutionary activities in the project complex. As far as the deaths of these two pigs are concerned, it was only a matter of time before they would have been killed, because the Black community has said over and over that "if you don't withdraw, stop brutalizing and murdering our people, then we're going to start shooting." So these pigs are just two in the long line which will be killed as we struggle for our freedom.

We have said that the housing projects are nothing but concentrations camps, an extension to the jail, and the invading pig department proved this correct. The first thing they did after the shooting. was to cordon the entire area off, this contained about 35 hundred people. No one was allowed to leave the immediate areathat they were in. If you were on the inside of the projects, then you stayed there, and if you were on the outside, then you remained there. The superintendent of pigs came in and set up headquarters on the playground, the same as generals do in a war zone. He personally took charge of the search and interrogation mission, which included some 35hundred people who were under preventative detention. The pigs

nearched over 350 spartments, ransacking the people's personal belongings, allegedly looking for weapons. The housing authorities provided the pigs with master keys, thereby giving entrance with or without permission of the residents. The superintendent of pigsappeared on t.v. displaying the weapons obtained from the 35 hundred prisoners, and cinked about this abows the need for national gun control laws. He said that within 48 hours he promised to have someone charged with the murders. So already we see that the Digs are simply looking for someone in the community to be scapegoats, and pay for the deaths of these two fascist deprayed beast who deserved to die. Already 4 brothers have been charged with this murder.

The pigs used all of their lackey subject parts against the community. All kinds of nigger detectives and social service pigs were in the community trying to calm things down and get information, The nigs made large sume of money available to anyone who would give up some information, The pigs' armed occupation body concentrated heavily on the project complex, hoping and waiting for a chance to shoot some niggers. Things were so uptight that they came running at the dropping of a bottle. Pigs were running all over the Black community crying and mouning, talking about the hell with community relations, and that they would make some niggers pay for this. The pigs are desperate, and we must be on the alert because they intend to increase their violence against our people,

The pig news media tried to make things appear as though the community was taking all of this lightly, However, an investigation revealed that the people were angry over being subjugated to preventative detention, their homes searched and ram-shacked and as one woman said, "being treated like convicts and ex-con-

We in the Black community expect the pigs to keep on doing this, because as long as they occupy our community, brutalizing and murdering our people we will kill them, (and we don't care how many different public relations programs they come from). We say that the pigs have nothing to say, because they are our enemies. Ain't nothing for them to do but get out of the Black and oppressed communities because we are going to keep on blowing their brains

Everyone must take time. Seize the Time, and begin to organize and construct community selfdefense groups. We must put ourselves in a position to maintain a self-defense based on the principles of a head for a head, a life for a life. By doing this we can let the pigs know that we will continue to bring death to them, until we have our freedom,

O-wing, the maximum security ward of Soledad, in the worst part of a prison described by its inmates as another Dachau. Locked into tiny, cold cells with only bars on one side and an open window letting in fog and cold sir on the other, the primoners shiver at night and roast during the day. Guards pass by the cells, spitting in at Hlack prisoners, cursing them, race-bairing. They encourage White and Chicano prisoners to do the same. "Twenty-four hours a day, in shifts, the foulest of taunts from the language of racist America," George Jackson calls it.

Inmates report numerous incidents of Black prisoners being set upon by Whites with hand-made knives, or just beaten up by a gang of other prisoners, Sometimes this is a way to get rid of both. More often, the Whites go free. The cursing from behind cell doors continues allday, every day, a constant drone which every once in a while causes a Black man to break down, screaming or lashing out at his persecutors. Then the prison guards have wun.

Once a man is locked up in jall, it is usually pretty easy for experienced guards to see that he stays there. Ruce-buiting, spitting, shoving finally induce the priloner to react, once he does, he lashes out at the guard, they have him for life, A man who misbehaves in prison isn't eligible for parole. A man who has a sentence with a maximum of life foces the gas chamber if he reacts.

Another incident; "A Black in-But the most important point mate by the name of P. refused to come out of his cell and wan repeatedly tear-gassed until he passed out. He was taken to the officers' area and when he regained consciousness a struggle insued and P, was wantonly beaten and called 'nigger' repeatedly, He was then taken to the hospital; he died the same day, His death was passed off as heart failure."

> When Black prisoners protest their treatment at the hands of the guards, they are almost always put in isolation in the "strip cells". Almost all the men of "maximum security" O-wing have spent time in one of these sixby-eight-foot metal cages. The front wall of each cage is steel bars covered with mesh.

> A solid wall along the corridor keeps light out from that side; the tiny windows in each cell were covered with a metal flap that is always closed, keeping the prisoners in near-total darkness.

> There is no furniture in the cells, and most have only a hole in the floor for a tollet. Tollet facilities in the strip cells can only be flushed from the outside by a guard. They are usually left unflushed for prolonged periods of time. The cages are almost never cleaned unless a medical inspection forces it.

> The naked prisoners kept in these cages are given no water to wash with, sparsely rationed toilet paper, no soap or facilities to wash or brush their teeth, Body filth piles up, There is no heat in the cages. Sometimes a small, stiff piece of canvas is thrown in to serve as a "blanket".

Twenty-nine days is the average stay in a strip cell. Twentynine days without light, clothes, a blanker, or cleaning facilities That's for talking back to a guard or less. At his own discretion the lowest-level guard can send a man to the strip cell for up to 60 days,

In the middle of January 1970 a group of seven Black and eight White prisoners from Soledad's U-wing-after months of vicious attempts by the guards to stir. up harred between Whites, Blacks and Chicanos-were released for the first time into = prison "exercise yard". Then, as Whiteprisoners watched with approval, and other Blacks looked on helplessly from their cells, the White towerguard overlooking the prison yard aimed his gun and fired at the ground. Three Black men died.

Three days later, the curouer's jury ruled the deaths were "jusriffable bonicide". The guard and the White prisoners agreed there had been a gang fight between White and Black prisoners and the guard shot to break it up.

The prison officials picked George Jacknon, Fleets Drumgo, and John Clutchette for the gas chamber. Some outside supporters think these three brothers offed the prison guard to deal justice in a system that refused to do so. Some people think these three brethers didn't do it at all, but were chosen as a scape-goats became the prison had reasons for wanting to get rid of them.

There is no question that the law in out to lynch them in either case. For months their lawyers were refused the right to question prisoners or inspect the site of the killing. Meanwhile, Y-wing haz been structurally altered beyond recognition, and key witnesses have been scattered to far-flung prisons throughout California.

And this is the lynching of men with a very definite political identity. Take George Jackson, for example -- a magnetic, tender man who knew how to reach out to five non-Black inmates whom he had been told tried to kill him, and forged a comradeship and awareness of who the real enemy is. He describes himself as "a dirty, a real dirty red."

He didn't start out in prison that way. George was arrested when he was 18 years old for second degree burglary (no weapons, no assault), and got sentenced to one year to life when he "copped a plea" without consulting a lawyer. And ten years have passed.

"This is the tenth year of this -actually the 28th, but I was too numb to feel the first 18," he mays in anger, jackson studies, works and writes 21 hours a day in his cell. "Time seems to be rushing away from me. In prison men generally sense a slowdown and narrowing in of time and space. This ten years (especially the last few months) has gone from me. It seems like ten days, its been like trying to hold water in your hands, or quick-silver in your finmers."

Ten years in prison have by force given hirth to a very full political understanding,

REPORT ON THE TRIAL OF LOS SIETE

The trial of Los Siete de la Raza is four weeks old. These are six brothers (the seventh hasn't been caughty charged with murdering police. officer Jumeph Brodnik on May 1, 1969 in the Mission District, the latin Barrio in San Francisco, Brodntk and his partner Paul McGoran were harassing the brothers, calling them names and bearing them up when McGoran's big .41 Magmim went off, killing Brodnik from a distance of alx inches.

The six brothers, Tony Martin ez, Mario Martinez Gary Lescallet, Nelson Rodriguez, HeBe Melendez and Jose Rios, were all activists in the Latin Com-Aturio, Tony, sud Nelson were going to the College of San Mateo, and were trying to recruit other brothers and staters into college. Tony and Nelson weren't even near Alvarado Street -- the scene of the shooting-on May L. They were framed with the rest of the brothers, on no evidence but Mc-Coran's testimony, and have been without even the most basic human rights.

The prosecution is really not to convict the brothers; they are asking for the death penalty in the case. They are also charging them with assault with intent to murder McGoran and with hurglary. McGoran, the third prosecution witness to testify so far, testified that he and Brodnik stopped the brothers because they saw one of them carrying a stereo

from a car into a house. Me-Goran testified that they were not suspicious because the brothers were all Latinos, but he did admit in a bearing a few months ago that he would be suspicious of anyone 'Brown, Blacker Chinese'. He testified that the brothers cursed at lidm (but denied that he said anything insulting and that Gary Lescallet punched him, that he was then knocked down and heard a shot--the shot that killed Brodnik.

Charles Garry is heading the team of lawyers defending Los Siete. The defense says that Mc Goran is a 'racist, a liar, and a ifrunk'. That he wan drunk on May I and trigger-happy, started threatening the brothers. picked a fight with Gary, and shot his partner by mistake. Me Goran has a long history of brutality, racism and lying, and the defense is planning to call witnesses who have been imbeky enough to have had experiences with McGoran's brand of "justice" in the past, Aiready, during cross-examination, Garry has brought out inconsistencies and lies in McGoran's testimony. Yer judge Laurence Mana refuses to let the defense question McGoran about personality traits or past experiences. In denying this basic right, Mana is forcing them to bring in character witnesses later, which is a violation of law in that it places the burden of proof on the defense instead of of America. the prosecution.

the case at the last minute after another less strict judge, had heard 13 months of pre trial motions. Mana acts like automaton, . Bustaining prosecution objections and sometimes takes on the role of prosecutor himself.

The jury took 2 weeks to select. Despite its shortage of poor and young people, this jury is strestive and open minded. It consists of 7 women and 5 men, most of them government or bank employees.

Everyday the courtroom and hall are crowded with supporters of Los Siete. When the courtroom is full, people fill up the other courts where Black or Brown prisoners are on trial. Los Siete's Defense Committee has made a point of educating people to the fact that all people of culor in the jails are political prisoners even if they don't have people on the sutside as Los Siete does. The incident of Los Siete is not an isolated one in the Brown community or any other third world community in San Francisco. The entire Brown movement is on trial with Los Siete. When the jury goes out, at the middle of August, Los Slete in calling for a national demonstration in San Francisco to demand the freedom of the b brothers, the 3 Mack men from Soledad prison framed for the killing of a guard and all other political prisoners in the jails

Now obviously the court punished appellant with a four-year prison term--without notice, hearing or counsel -- in accordance with its view that he was guilty of extremely serious misconduct amounting to an intentional assault upon the administration of justice. But in appellant's view he was guilty of nothing more than attempting to assert his claims to be represented by Charles Garry or alternatively, to represent himself, preserve his objections to the denial of those claims, and protest the fact that his trial proceeded without any defense whatsoever being presented on his behalf. (4)

MR, SEALE: If you let me defend myself, you could instruct me on the proceedings that I can act, but I have to just --

But regardless of whether he is entitled to such relief, it is clear that the procedures by which the conflict between appellant's view and the radically different view of the court was resolved, violated his rights. Precisely because two such conflicting views of the facts were entertainable, it was essential that fair and regular procedures be used to determine appellant's guilt. The procedures used below were markedly deficient under present-day standards for the trial of serious contempts in the federal courts, and for this reason also reversal is required. (Arguments II-V, infra)

For in recent years there has been gradual recognition of the need to restrict both the substantive scope of offenses subject to the contempt power (6) and the manner in which that power is exercised. (7) This development has culminated in a number of recent decisions by the United States Supreme Court, most notably Bloom v. Illinois, 391 U.S. 194 (1968) and Harris v. United States, 382 U.S. 162 (1965), These decisions signal a new approach to the law of contempt, (8) for they have overruled (9) or underminded (10) previous cases, and vindicated those who have long condemned the ensentially despotic nature of the traditional power of judges to summarily punish for criminal contempt, (11)

In Bloom v. Illinois, supra, the Supreme Court finally brought the crindual commun power within the hounds of our traditional crinatual jurisprodence in rating that "criminal contempt is a crime to the ordinary sense and

"convictions for criminal contempt, not infrequently resulting in extremely serious penalties are indistinguishable from those obtained under ordinary criminal laws" (391 U.S. at 201, 207-08), The court concluded that the criminal contemnor must therefore be accorded the traditional procedural protections of our system of criminal justice.

further respect for judges and courts is entitled to more consideration than the interest of the individual not to be subjected to serious criminal punishment without the benefit of all the procedural protections worked out carefully over the years and deemed fundamental to our system of justice. Genuine respect, which alone can lend true dignity to our judicial establishment, will be engendered, not by the fear of unlimited authority, but by the firm administration of the law through those institutionalized procedures which have been worked out over the centuries. (391 U.S. at 208)

Bloom overruled a 150-year line of authority which had held that an individual charged with contempt was not constitutionally entitled to a jury trial. (END OF FOOTNOTE)

The trial judge's action in the instant case represents an extreme example of the potential for abuse inherent in the power to imprison for contempt, Appellant was sentenced to four years imprisonment at the conclusion of a summary proceeding, at which he was accorded none of the traditional procedural safeguards of the criminal law for acts arising out of a personal clash between him and the man who then purported to act as prosecutor, judge and fact-finder. This is completely inconsistent with the spirit and philosophy of Bloom v. Illinois, supra, and can only erode the respect for the judicial system which the contempt power purports to serve.

Appellant's claim that he was entitled to be represented by Charles Garry or, at the least, to present his new defense, was central to the entire controversy between Seale and the court and virtually all of the resulting to contempt convictions, it is our contention in Arguments II-VIII, infra, that the contempt convictions must be reversed regardloss of whether Scale or the court was right on this basic issue, that there can be little question that the cours erred in denying defoudant Seale opportunity to present a defense either through retained counsel of his choice or through self-representation. This action by the court, invistation of Seale's constitutional and statutory rights, gives added support to Arguments H-VIII and also constitutes an independent ground for reversal (ii), Infra pp. 49-53)

A. THE COURT WRONGFULLY DENIED DEFENDANT SUALES. RIGHT TO COUNSEL OF HIS CHOICE OR, ALTERNATIVELY, HIS RIGHT TO BE PRESENTHIM.

Facts

August 27, 1969 the defendants in the case of United States v. Dellinger moved for a costingance on the ground that attorneys Charles Carry and William Konstler, because of other trial engagements, would be unable to participate if the trial took place September 24, alleging that their participation was "absolutely essential to assure the defendance herein adequate representation at their trial." Garry's attached affidavit alleged specifically that (1) he had been designated chief trial counsel by the defendants, and (2) he was attorney of record for defendant Seale "whom I have represented for several years." (13) This motion was denied that same day by the trial court. (Record on Appeal, Items No. 26, 28)

(13) The strached affidavit of attorney Leonard Weinglass alleged that Seale's incarceration in San Francisco on a Connecticut murder charge had made it "virtually impossible for ... (Garry) to represent his client adequately in connection with the charges against (him) pending before this court," and had prevented Seale from "indispensable consultation with his co-defendants," (END OF FOOTNOTE)

September 9, 1969 the defense presented a renewed emergency motion for a continuance until November 15, 1969 on the ground that Garry had developed a serious medical condition requiring immediate surgery which would make it impossible for him to participate in a trial commencing September 24. (14) Supporting affidavits by Garry and Seale alleged that Seale had selected Garry as his trial attorney and refused to go to trial without him, requesting a severance if necessary, because Garry had demonstrated "unique professional ability, particularly in courtroom strategy and tactics, to provide proper and adequate defense to a Black militant charged with crime." (15)

(14) Record on Appeal, Item No. 29. Supporting affidavite by Garry and his physicians gave details of his medical condition indicating that he was taken seriously ill and hospitalized August 25, 1969 for a gall bladder condition requiring surgical removal of the bladder at the earliest possible date, and that the required nospitalization and recuperation would prevent him from trying any cases prior to November 15, 1969.

(15) Garry's affidavit alleged that Seale "insists that I defend him upon the indictment herein, and I am willing and able to do so, on or after Nov. 15, 1969;" and consequently was moving "for a continuance of trial, or alternatively, for severance and continuance." Seale's supporting affidavit explained why Garry was his chisen trial attorney:

My structer in the incimatant mane, and generally, is CHARLES R. GARRY of San Francisco, Callformis, whom I have carefully selected and chosen as my stories hazed on extensive valuable exper lence.

NEW ORLEANS GESTAPO FORCE BEATS AND JAILS MOTHER, SON AND PREGNANT SISTER

July 18, 1970

The nightmure started for Mrs. Vivian Nicholson when she was visited at her home by about 10 pts detectives and four uniformed plg members of the New Orleans Police Department, The visit took place between 3:00 a.m. and 4:00 a.m. on the morning of the 13th

of May 1970. The large detachment of pigs was headed by a Black pig detective, bootlicking nigger Sergeant Sam Haine (alian Curley Sam), Culey Sam led his White pig masters to the front door of the house at 3409 Clouet St. in the predominately Black 5th Ward of the city. They knocked and when Mrs. Nicholson answered the door the nigger pig asked her about a red and White 66 Chevrolet truck parked in front of the door. She told him that the truck was



Mrs. Nicholson, and Marilyn Jones were both brutally beaten.

hers. Some of the pigs were examining the truck at the time and Mrs. Nicholson wanted to know why. The pig oinked that the truck was used in a robbery and that the truck had a dent in the front of it, made when someone had thrown a hammer while the alleged robbers were making their get-a-way. No dent could be found on the truck The pig gang left then, but returned later to ask Mrs. Nicholson where her son was night. She told them that her son Herbert Nicholson-age 18) was not home and that he did not use the truck that night. The pigs told Mrs. Nicholson that they "caught a boy" and that the "boy" had implicated her son saying that he was driving the truck. Meanwhile, the pigs had the truck towed away to the police vehicle pound without her permission,

The pigs left, only to return again the next morning, this time knocking on the rear door of the house, Mrs. Nicholson answered the door after hearing a shot and into her house, Mrs. Nichelson helpleasly followed behind the house-invading pigs asking for a search warrant. Black pig Curley Sam answered her question. "B-- h, we don't need no g-- n

warrant' in the house the pigs completely ransacked all of the rooms. They overturned furniture, tore up the drawers, broke down kitchen cabmets, messed up the clothes, Three of the big bad pigs held Mrs. Nicholson at bay while the others continued to disarrange her home. While she was being held captive in the back she heard her 51 year old invalid husband scream in pain and terror as the pigs in front dumped him from his bed, He landed on the floor with a thud and the pigs walked right over him. After awhile the pig force left ... finding nothing. Her younger children ages 16 years to nine months huddled together in childly fear of the beasts who had invaded their home.

Mrs. Nicholson tried to reorganire the house but to no avail... some of her things were utterly destroyed.

The nightmare was over for awhile, but later that day it returned with the reappearance of the nightmarish intruders. This time, they fliegally entered the front door, once again supposedly searching for her young son, Herbert. And, once again Black pig-Sam led the ransacking "search", repeatedly cursing Mrs. Nicholson and insulting her feminity. They left but only to come back at least three times a week until the night of July 17th when they entered unwarranted and found the son, Berbert there. They had banged on the door until Mrs. Nicholson knowingly answered, allowing them to do their thing, i.e. illegally breaking into Black and/or poor) people sprivacy and homes. This time they entered with 357 Magnums drawn and ready to fire. They claimed to have a warrant but refused to show it. They started the "search", As the first four pigs reached the kitchen

The filthy, perverted of the N.C.C.F. here. pigs refused to allow them to dress after repeated pleas by Mrs. Nicholson, Herbert and the stater, Miss Marilyn Johns were put in one the squad cars and taken off to Central Lockup, Mrs. Nicholson was taken a little while later after the pigs had a little fun by finding out who could insult her most. After a squad car took her, the remaining plgs stayed behind to continue their "search" and terrorize the remaining 10 small children and their invalid father.

When Mrs. Nicholson arrived at the Central Lockup, she was unhered into a room where her eyes gazed down in pain on her son slouched in a chair, handcuffed behind the back of it. She naw a pig, his foot between her son's legs, mashing his genitals against the seal of the chair. She screamed and they forced her into an adjoining room where young prognant Marilyn was standing, crying bitter tears of her people's long suffering. The mother joined her and echoed her cries. They could still bear the screams from the next room where the three pigs were beating Herbert. She thought she heard the sounds of other sadistic beatings coming from other sections of the giant Central-Lockup.

Later, the son was booked with about eight trumped-up charges ... crimes that were marked "unsolved' on the books because they hadn't been pinned on a nigger yet. The mother and sister were charged with being accessories after the fact by harboring a fugitive. Mrs. Nicholson and the sister were batted out the next morning but Herbert Nicholson is still there in dire need of medical treatment,



1970 POLITICAL PRISONER NEW HAVEN, CONN, LONNIE MCLUCAS B.P.P.



Brother Lonnie McLucas one of the New Haven 9 separated from the rest of his comrades by the fascist, was railroaded through the second trial week.

On Tuesday morning (7-14-70) Mrs. Mc-Lucas arrived from Fayetteville North Carolina to be there when her revolutionary son faced the fascist Judge Mulvey. Her remarks after the court adjourned were, "those jurors are not necessary, the judge has already decided Lonnie's case." Anybody observing the trial can readily see that the court scene is a direct contradiction to what a fair trial is supposed to be about as defined by the Constitution of the United States. But then for Black people, there is no such thing as Constitutional rights. Lonnie faced Judge Mulvey on Tuesday along with 9 White jurors and 3 Black ones, none of whom are his peers. The judge still continues to hold court in a room which sometimes seats only 25 people. Most of those who enter the courtroom are White. The pigs have devised a plan in which as soon as the court session is out you have to get right in line and wait 2 to 3 hours before the next court session resumes.

Last weeks trial included testimony from the pigs who supposedly found the body of Alex Rackley. The pig coroner brought in pictures of the body which no one knewabout, not even the defense. Loretta Lukes who was arrested along with the New Haven 9, and turned states evidence, also testified. She said that she hoped that her testimony would convince the state to drop charges and go lenient on her.

One pig who testified said that they had found a note in Rackley's pocket, which the state said is from Ericka Huggins and Bobby Seale about a bomb threat in Oregon. The note was supposedly to have been under water for several hours, but the ink was not smeared. No more information was given about the note. The same sig also said that six days after the body was found he and another pig went back to the place where the body was found to look for more evidence. He also said they searched and dug up the earth, he said they used a pump to pump the water from the river to go under the earth to shift it. The defense objected because after six days they could have found anything from the river with the pump.

He was then overruled, the pig continued to testify that he found a .45 cartridge and a bullet shell. He also took 7 or 8 cartons of evidence to Washington, but nothing was said about the results. The local milical examiner testified for most of the afternoon (Wed. 7-15-70). He brought slides which were just shown for the judge and the lawyer, the jury was excused. The defense objected to the slides because there had already been pictures shown of the body. The judge then admitted most of the slides to the jury, then the doctor said that they (the slides) showed where Rackley had been shot, burnt, bruised and tied.

The defense will cross examine him tomorrow about the cause of death (whether the two shots fired at Rackley killed him or not). The doctor made all sorts of state-

ments about the marks on Rackley's body. Fri. 7-17-70) Frances Carter was on the stand. States attorney Markle started out by asking the judge if Frances could be declared a hostile witness, then they went through legal argument as to why she could be declared hostile. Koskoff argued the request by Markle by stating that Miss. Carter could not be declared hostile, just because she couldn't remember exactly what went on, Judge Mulvey declared Frances as a hostile witness, which permitted the statement that was made by Frances when first arrested to be read to the jury. The statement included that Frances was at work at the time of the aresi. S'in aid on the 18th of May 1969, she went to the Panther Headquarters, 365 Orchid Street, and saw Lonnie McLucas, George Edwards, and Margaret Hudgins. She said she asked Lonnie what was going on, and he replied that George Sams had disciplined a brother quite severly in the basement; but that he would be alright.

Markle began to cross examine Miss. Carter on the statement that she had given at the time of her arrest. He asked her what rank did Lonnie hold? She said, Field Lieutenant. Markle asked her was Lonnie in charge? She said no, Jose Gongalves was. Q. In May what position did he (Lonnie) hold? A. Field Lieutenant. Q. Who was in charge in May? A. No one person in particular. Q. What type of person is Lonnie? A. He was a very gentle person, Q. Did this gentle person go to the brother who was disciplined in the basement to administer first aid? A. No, a person was ordered to do this by George Sams. Q. Did he (Lonnie) know that? A. Yes. Q. On May 20 did you go to Lonnie and ask him to administer first aid to the brother? A.NO Q. Where did George Sams come from? A. California. Q. Who was he accompanied by? A. A few people. Q. Were the people taken upstairs? A. George only allowed certain people up there, he bragged about the treatment that he had administered to the brother. Q. Was this about the time of the retreat? A. I don't remember. Q. Was it about the time of Bobby Seale's arrival? A. No.

During the afternoon the F.B.I. agent was put on the stand by Markle. The pig testified that he had apprehend Lonnie McLucas at Western Union in Salt Lake City, Utah. The pig said that after he had advised Lonnie of his Constitutional rights, Lonnie asked him, what was the penalty in Connecticut for assesory to murder. The pig then pulled out written notes from the interview that was supposed to have taken place with Lonnie McLucas in Salt Lake City, Koskoff asked the judge if he could have enough time to compair the note that had been handwritted, with the typewritten copy of what happened in Salt Lake City. court was adjourned until Tuesday, (July

REVEALING METHODS OF INTERROGATION

earlier article titled, "Exposing Fascist Methods of Investigation' . an interrogation is a more sophisticated method of obtaining information from suspects and other reluctant persons. The information that may be obtained can be used to aid the fascist pig law enforcement agencies, it is used extensively throughout the world not only by the pig police, but also the army intelligence.

To deal with an effective weaponagainst an interrogation is to be prepared with a knowledge of how it works and how it is used. Thus the outset of the questioning one can be more aware of its weaknesses and analyze how simple it can be to avoid the flow of any kind of information no matter how unimportant it may

The article below outlines the techniques of interrogations used by the fascist law enforcement agencies. The material contained in this article is used as guide lines for interrogations. One should study this article carefully to become more broadly aware of the trickery and paychological pressure used against many people who have been tricked by this mind probing weapon. ***

INTERROGATIONS

1. Terman

For the purpose of simplifying the treatment of interrogations a special meaning will be attached to some of the terms used, It should be understood that these conventions are not universally accepted.

a. Interrogations. An interrogation is a questioning of a person suspected of having committed an offense or of a person who is reluctant to make a full disclosure of information in his possession which is pertinent to the inves-

b. Witness, A witness is usually interviewed, but he may be interrogated when he is suspected of lying or of withholding pertinent information,

c. Suspect: A suspect in an offense is a person whose guilt is considered on reasonable grounds to be a practical possibility.

d Subject. The term subject will be used here most commonly to represent the person, whether witness or suspect, who is being interviewed or interrogated. A subject is ordinarily interrogated for one of the following purposes:

1) To obtain a confession to the crime.

2) To induce the subject to make admissions,

3) To learn the facts and cirgumstances surrounding a crime. 4) To learn the identity of ac-

5) To develop information which will lead to the recovery of the fruits of the crime.

6) To discover the details of any other crimes in which the sus-

pect participated.

2. The Interrogator: The interrogator must be able to dominate the subject, not through use of his formal authority but because his personality commands respect. If he reveals any wavering tendencies the suspect may discover the means of resisting the inter-ogation. To inspire full confidence, the force of the investigator's personality should be tempered by an understanding and aympathetic attitude. The suspect who has been forced to cooperate with hostfle organizations will tell his story much more readily if he feels that the investigator understands his helplessness and is insitued to take his plight into consideration. The fellowing qualifications and traits are destruble in an interrogator

3. Conduct of the Interrogator. The behavior of the interrogator at usually establishes the atmosphere that will prevail throughout the interrogation. It is of great Importance for the investigator to develop an effective personality that will induce desire to respond in the subject. The following are some of the more useful reminders concerning attitude and de-

a. Dominate the interview. The interrogator must always be in command of the situation. The arrength of his personality must constantly be felt by the subject.

b. Distracting Mannectants. The subject must be impressed with the seriousness of the interrogutor's purpose. Pacing the room, smoking, "doodling," and similar forms of behavior should be avoided, since they tend to convey a sense of mattentiveness or a luck of concentration. The investigator should seat himself glose to the subject. The full weight of his personality must be brought to bear on the emotional situation. Distance or obstructions provide the subject with a small degree of confidence and relief.

c. Language. The speech of the Interrogator should beadapted to the aubject's cultural level, Profanity and vulgarity should be avoided, since they diminish the effectiveness of the interrogator by compromising his dignity or antagonizing the subject. Where the subject may shy away from words such as "assault" and "steal", he may not hesitate to admit that he "hit" or "took". It is a natural tendency for a person to describe his conduct in terms of emphem-

d. Dress, Civilian dress is more likely to inspire confidence and friendship in a criminal than a uniform. The night of a protruding gun or filly may arouse an enmity or defensive attitude on the part of the criminal.

e. Attitude. There is an endless series of locations with which the investigator can attractively decorate his role in the administration of justice.

1. Preliminary Conduct, Before beginning the questioning, be must advise the suspect of his rights against nelf-incrimination and inform him that he does not need to answer the questions and that if he does answer, his answers can be used against him.

c. Presence of Other Persons, It is desirable to restrict the number of persons present at an interrogation. If a confession is obtained the defense may claim the existence of duress because of the presence of five or ten police

officers. 4. Place! If at all practicable, the interrogation should take place to the investigator's office or at least in a room of his own choice. The subject should be deprived of every psychological advantage, in his own home be may be confident, indignant, or recalcitrant, he is more keenly aware of his rights and more reluctant to tell of his indiscretions of criminal behavior within the walls of bis home. In his own affice, the investigatur possesses all the advantages. The atmosphere suggests the Invincibility of the forces of the law.

5. The Interrogation Booms The room chosen for the interregation should provide freedom from distractions Secondarily, it

should not be designed to give encouragement to the subject. The following ideal requirements are listed with these two principles as

a: Privacy, Interruptions dispel an atmoshpere that may have been carefully created by the intercogator hence, the following are deairable:

1) One door, Several doors suggest possible interruptions and destroy the feeling of inevitability.

2) Absence of windows or view,

3) Sound preofing.

4) Telephone without bell, b. Simplicity, Distracting influences should be kept to a minimum. The suspect may strive to avoid the investigator's concentration by focusing his attention on some object in the room which Suggests a different train of

1) Medium sized room.

2) hard walls. Pictures and charts are distracting.

5) No glaring lights.

4) 5thimum furniture. c. Seating Arrangements, The aubject and the investigator should be seated with no large furniture between them.

1) Chair. Armiess, straightback chair for the suspect,

2) Table or Desk, The investigator requires a flat surface on which to place papers and articles of evidence.

5) Suspect. Seating the suspect with his back to the door further deprives him of any hope of interruptions or distructions,

d. Technical Aids: Although the investigator should be along with the subject it is desirable to have facilities for others to observe and hear the suspect during the interrogation. Persons such as the prosecuting attorney will find this opportunity to observe the prospective defendant invaluable in preparing his case.

1) Recording Installation Important interrogation and confessions should be recorded.

2) Listening Device, A hidden microphone such as a "live" telephone should be installed.

3) Two-Way Mirror, This device appears to be a plain mirror on one side but permits a person on the other side to see through without being observed. Unfortunstely the typical two-way mirror installationis obvious and is fam-Harto the experienced criminal. A more deceptive arrangement can be devised with a little ingenuity. A framed picture with a mirror strip border is less familiar, A medicine chest with a mirror door will pass unnoticed if a small sink is installed beneath it,

6. Selection of Technique and Approacht

The interrogator must first classify or analyze his subject with the aid of information or criminal records. With first offenders and those subject to feelings of regret, repentance, and mental anguish, a direct appeal on a friendly basts is more effective. The subject may develop a doubt as to whether there is a strong case against him if widely varying techniques are used. ROCKFORD STORE OWNER INTIMIDATES SMALL CHILDREN

The business and stores in our communities are there for a sole purpose, that being to make aprofit off of Black people. These stores and businesses in the Black community are robbing, intimidating, and exploiting, and in return excluding all concern for the safety and well being of the people living In the community.

An Incident occurred at one of the many racist stores in the Black Community of Rockford. The Quick Pie food store is located on School Street. The name Quick Pic is fitting of the type and quality of the food, Mothers on occasions will send their children here to rdck up small items such as bread and milk, Primarily, this avaricious greedy businessman makes his profit by opening ear-Her in the morning than the larger stores and closing later in the evening. The manager of the Quick Pic store, a racist, reactionary, child abusing punk, has a history of inistreating and intimidating small children who come into the store on errands for their mothers. Rase Marie Smith, who is nine years old, and two of her girfriends went to the Quick Pic food store on an errand for her mother, Her mother had given her some food stamps to purchase some floor wax, washing powder, and some black pepper. The stipulations on food stamps are that only food items are to be purchased with them, but on namerous occasions this particular store, whose only purpose is to make a profit off of the Black people in the community, will allow nonfood Items to be bought. When Rose Marie got to the store she handed the manager the food stamps and told him what her mother had asked for. This avaricious pig allowed her to get the washing powder and floor wax, but said that since black pepper was not food she would have to pur it back. (GET THIS, black pepper is not a food stuff.) Since time, immeasurable time people have been eating black peper on food, and this racist, reactionary punk is going to say it's not a food. Rather than let her put the pepper back on the shelf this PIG said that he would buy the pepper for her if she would stand before him and est it, being confused and frightened Rose Marie began crying and went to put the pepper on the shelf. This pig then told her to keep the pepper because he was satisfied at this enjoyable feat. When Rose Marie came home cry-

ing her mother asked her what was wrong and she explained the unusual act this jackanape store manager had tried to get her to perform for his pleasure. The store has been accused the manager) of selling little girls apples and candy with razor blades in them, and catering to the little boys with favors of money. As some of the mothers said something is wrong here, it appears that this sick demented racist is using the store as a place to manifest his deranged perversion, which can be noted in the sets of most capitalist aspiring pigs. Rose Marie's mother and members of the community went down to the store to exercise the power of the people. When they arrived. he lied and claimed that the young sisters were lying, however a quick historic analysis points him out as guilty, and deserving of being ran out the Black community. The pig went on lying, talking about "you colored people just want to take over." And Miss Lowis replied, that if that was the case, she would be running the store now.

People like this racist, reactionary pig have no business around our children, let alone running a store in the Black community. It is time we moved to run all the perverts out of our community masquerading as builneasmen, sucking up the very worth of our community for profit, committing sexual acts typical of the supporters of the affluent society against our children.

Since this particular incident, Quick Pic has changed managers, The store in now under the management of a Puerto Rican, however the service is still the same old high priced service accustomed to capitalism. So the next move will be for the people to collectively control the store, but this cannot come about without a struggle. And that is what we are preparing ourselves for, a struggle to give the people the best. and destroy the capitalist system.

TORTURE IN SAIGON

Torture by the Saigon police has been vividly illustrated during the recent crackdown on Vietnamese student dissent, On April 21, ten of the recently arrested young people were released.

Do Huu But lies in semi-shock in a laboratory at the College of Agriculture which has been converted into a dispensary for the ten released prisoners, His fingernails are blackened from having pins pushed underneath, lie appears to be almost deaf, 'Soapy water was put into his ears and then his ears were beaten," a student explained.

Miss Quo Huong, a teacher of philosophy at Doan Thi Diem high school in Can Tho, forces a tired smile when visitors come. Her knees are swollen three times their normal size and black-andblue welts cover ber tiny arms.

"They best me with their police clubs," she stated simply.

Even worse than the torture was the indignity of boing completely undressed in front of several policemen who watched and drank whiskey while she was being beaten. At times Miss Que Hoong's flance, Nguyen Ngoc Phong, was brought into the room to watch her being tornired an attempt to get him to sign confession po-

Liss House Thao, Deputy Chairman of the Van Hanh University student association, was arrested on Murch 13. He is one of the most healthy of the ten young posple released and one of the few in good enough physical condition to give an extended interview, He described his five weeks in jull;

"For the first three days, the police heat me continuously. They didn't ask me any questions or to sign anything. They just beat my knee caps and neck with their billy claims. Then they beat me with chair legs, When a chair leg broke, they took another one. I was besten until I was unconscious, When I regained consciousness, they beat me again. Finally, after three days, they asked me to sign a

'They read the paper, but they would not let me see it," Thio said. "I wouldn't sign it, so they beat me some more.

Than said that he does not know why he had been arrested nor could be see the government's chjective in releasing him, just that they had no reason to arrest us in the first place. The government claims that it did not tornire or manhandle the students, but that they exhausted themselves to make themselves appear III. The government has not commented on the presence of the black-and-blue welt, the swollen kneecaps, or the blackened fingernails.

Of particular concern to the students is that many others are still in jail. The condition of three of the students who were not released and who did not appear with the others in the April 20 Military Field Court trial because they were 'too III' was described by the newspaper Tin Sang (Morning News) on April 11:

RULES OF THE BLACK PANTHER PARTY NATIONAL HEADQUARTERS 1048 PERALTA ST. OAKLAND, CALIFORNIA

Every member of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY throughout this country of racist America must abide by these rules as functional members of this party, CENTRAL COMMITTEE members, CENTRAL STAFFS, and LOCAL STAFFS, including all captains subordinate to either national, state, and local leadership of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY will enforce these rules. Length of suspension or other disciplinary action necessary for violation of these rules will depend on national decisions by national, state or state area, and local committees and staffs where said rule or rules of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY WERE VIOLATED.

Every member of the party must know these verbatum by heart. And apply them daily. Each member must report any violation of these rules to their leadership or they are counter-revolutionary and are also subjected to suspension by the BLACK PANTHER PARTY.

THE RULES ARE:

- 1. No party member can have narcotics or weed in his possession while doing party work.
- 2. Any party member found shooting narcotics will be expelled from
- 3. No party member can be DRUNK while doing daily party work. 4. No party member will violate rules relating to office work, general meetings of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY, and meetings of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY ANYWHERE.
- 5. No party member will USE, POINT, or FIRE a weapon of any kind unnecessarily or accidentally at anyone,
- 6. No party member can join any other army force other than the BLACK LIBERATION ARMY.
- 7. No party member can have a weapon in his possession while DRUNK or loaded off narcotics or weed.
- 8. No party member will commit any crimes against other party members or BLACK people at all, and cannot steal or take from the people, not even a needle or a piece of thread.
- 9. When arrested BLACK PANTHER MEMBERS will give only name, address, and will sign nothing. Legal first aid must be understood
- by all Party members. 10. The Ten Point Program and platform of the BLACK PANTHER
- PARTY must be known and understood by each Party member. 11. Party Communications must be National and Local.
- 12. The 10-10-10-program should be known by all members and also understood by all members.
- 13. All Finance officers will operate under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of Finance.
 - 14. Each person will submit a report of dails work.
- 15. Each Sub-Section Leader Section Leader, Lieutenant, and Captain must submit Daily reports of work.
- 16. All Panthers must learn to operate and service weapons correctly. 17. All Leadership personnel who expel a member must submit this information to the Editor of the Newspaper, so that it will be published in the paper and will be known by all chapters and branches.
- 18, Political Education Classes are mandatory for general member-
- 19. Only office personnel assigned to respective offices each day should be there. All others are to sell papers and do Political work out in the community, including Captains, Section Leaders, etc.
- 20. COMMUNICATIONS all chapters must submit weekly reports in writing to the National Headquarters.
- 21. All Branches must implement First Aid and/or Medical Cadres. 22. All Chapters, Branches, and components of the BLACK PAN-THER PARTY must submit a unnithly Financial Report to the Ministry of Finance, and also the Central Committee.
- 23. Everyone in a leadership position must read no less than two hours per day to keep abreast of the changing political situation.
- 24. No chapter or branch shall accept grants, poverty funds, money or any other aid from any government agency without confacting the National Headquarters.
- 25. All chapters must adhere to the policy and the alcology laid down by the CENTRAL COMMITTEE of the BLACK PANTHER PARIL
- 26. All Branches must submit weekly reports to writing to their respective Chapters

What We Want What We Believe



Huey P. Newton Minister of Defense Black Panther Party

1. We want freedom. We want power to determine the destiny of our Black Community.

We believe that black people will not be free until we are able to determine our destiny.

2. We want full employment for our people.

We believe that the federal government is responsible and obligated to give every man employment or a guaranteed income. We believe that if the white American businessmen will not give full employment, then the means of production should be taken from the businessmen and placed in the community so that the people of the community can organize and employ all of its people and give a high standard of living

3. We want an end to the robbery by the CAPITALIST of our Black Community.

We believe that this racist government has robbed us and now we are demanding the overdue debt of forty acres and two mules. Forty acres and two mules was promised 100 years ago as restitution for slave labor and mass murder of black people. We will accept the payment in currency which will be distributed to our many communities. The Germans are now aiding the Jews in Israel for the genocide of the Jewish people. The Germans murdered six million Jews. The American racist has taken part in the slaughter of over fifty million black people; therefore, we feel that this is a modest demand that we make.

4. We want decent housing, fit for shelter of human beings.

We believe that if the white landlords will not give decent housing to our black community, then the housing and the land should be made into cooperatives so that our community, with government aid, can build and make decent housing for its people.

We want education for our people that exposes the true nature of this decadent American society. We want education that teaches us our true history and our role in the present-day society.

We believe in an educational system that will give to our people a knowledge of self. If a man does not have knowledge of himself and his position in society and the world, then he has little chance to relate to anything else.

6. We want all black men to be exempt from military service.

We believe that Black people, should not be forced to fight in the mifitary service to defend a racist government that does not protect us. We will not fight and kill other people of color in the world who, like black people, are being victimized by the white racist government of America. We will protect ourselves from the force and violence of the racist police and the racist military, by whatever means necessary.

7. We want an immediate end to POLICE BRUTALITY and MURDER of black people.

We believe we can end police brutality in our black community by organizing black self-defense groups that are dedicated to defending our black community from racist police oppression and brutality. The Second Amendment to the Constitution of the United States gives a right to bear arms. We therefore believe that all black people should arm themselves for self-defense.

8. We want freedom for all black men held in federal, state, county and city prisons and jails.

We believe that all black people should be released from the many jails and prisons because they have not received a fair and impartial trial.

 We want all black people when brought to trial to be tried in court by a jury of their peer group or people from their black communities, as defined by the Constitution of the United States.

We believe that the courts should follow the United States Constitution so that black people will receive fair trials. The 14th Amendment of the U.S. Constitution gives a man a right to be tried by his peer group. A peer is a person from a similar economic, social, religious, geographical, environmental, historical and racial background. To do this the court will be forced to select a jury from the black community from which the black defendant came. We have been, and are being tried by all-white juries that have no understanding of the "average reasoning man" of the black community.

10. We want land, bread, housing, education, clothing, justice and peace. And as our major political objective, a United Nations-supervised plebiscite to be held throughout the black colony in which only black colonial subjects will be allowed to participate, for the purpose of determining the will of black people as to their national destiny.

When, in the course of human events, it becomes necessary for one people to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another, and to assume, among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the laws of nature and nature's God entitle them, a decent respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the separation.

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal; that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights; that among these are life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. That, to secure these rights, governments are instituted among men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed; that, whenever any form of government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the right of the people to alter or to abolish it, and to institute a new government, laying its foundation on such principles, and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their safety and bappiness. Prudence, indeed, will dictate that governments long established should not be changed for light and transient causes; and, accordingly, all experience hath shown, that mankind are more disposed to suffer, while evils are sufferable, than to right themselves by abolishing the forms to which they are accustomed. But, when a long train of abuses and usurpations, pursuing invariably the same object, evinces a design to reduce them under absolute despotism, it is their right, it is their duty, to throw off such government, and to provide new guards for their future security.
